Aim

- Develop an instrument to assess health-related quality of life among sarcoma patients for use in research and clinical care

Methods

- Semi-structured interviews will be conducted with sarcoma patients (N=77)
- Inclusion criteria:
 - A confirmed diagnosis of sarcoma; age 18 years or older; informed consent provided
- Exclusion criteria:
 - GIST or Kaposi sarcoma or Carcinosarcoma diagnosis
 - Having any psychiatric condition or cognitive impairment that would hamper participation in interview/completion of self-reported questionnaires.
